


Remembering The Hon. John Wooley



John B. Wooley, '56, passed away February 15, 2019. He was 92.

Wooley graduated from Wichita High School East in 1944 and enlisted in the U.S. Navy on his 18th birthday. He then worked for Dillion grocery store and the Boeing Airplane Company for a short time before enrolling at Wichita State University. Upon graduation, he started at Washburn Law and graduated and passed the bar in February 1956. He returned to Wichita where he started practicing at the firm of McClellan, Michaud, and Robbins and later joined the county attorney staff before forming a partnership and practicing law with Marvin J. Martin.

Wooley is most well-known for his service as a federal magistrate judge in Wichita, a role he held for more than 24 years. He had a love for both Wichita State and Washburn Law, and with his late wife Colleen, was very generous to both schools through scholarship and program gifts.

Remembering Winton Hinkle



Winton M. Hinkle, '68, passed away January 12, 2019. He was 76.

Hinkle grew up in Garden City and later attended Emporia State University, earning his teaching degree. He later chose to attend Washburn Law where he graduated at the top of his class and served as editor-in-chief of the Washburn Law Journal.

Upon graduation, he accepted a position with a prominent law firm in Wichita, and thus began what became a highly distinguished and respected 46-year legal career. He co-founded Wichita's second-largest law firm, Hinkle Law LLC, and became what many considered to be the expert in municipal finance, bond law, and tax and securities codes. Hinkle directly contributed to the growth and development of many important Wichita-area businesses.

He also maintained involvement with Washburn through the Law Alumni Association Board of Governors, including serving a three-year term as its president. In 2015, he was recognized with the Washburn School of Law's Lifetime Achievement Award.
