Admissions

- Please pay your **seat deposit** by the date indicated on your acceptance letter [online](#), by phone, or by mailing it to the address at the bottom of this page.
- If a final transcript reflecting your Bachelor's Degree was not included in your original application packet, please submit a new transcript once your final grades and degree are reflected to the Law School Admissions Council (LSAC). **Financial aid will not be released to you until your transcript has been received and processed by our office.** Failure to provide an official transcript by October 15, 2023 will result in the administrative withdrawal from all classes.
- If you have decided not to attend Washburn Law, please notify the Admissions Office in writing by mail or e-mail at admissions@washburnlaw.edu. This enables your seat to be offered to another applicant.

Financial Aid

- Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Once Financial Aid has your FAFSA, you will be sent either a letter requesting more information or an award letter.
- Accept your federal financial aid through your [MyWashburn](#) account.

Fall 2023 Enrollment

- Pre-enrollment of classes for the entering Fall 2023 class is not required. **The Admissions Office will formally enroll you in your first semester courses.** This will typically happen by the end of July.
